**Purpose & General Provisions:**  
The Risk Management & Tort Defense Division (RMTD) offers a property insurance premium discount of up to 10% to state agencies and universities that establish and maintain a comprehensive and effective Property Loss Management Program. The discount shall be applied against the participant's budgeted property insurance premium in FY2015.

**Requirements and Documentation:**  
Participants must complete the following during FY 2014 to be eligible for a premium discount in FY2015:

- 1) Review your property claims activity report for the past four years by October 1, 2013. Reviewers must include at least your contact person for this program, your RMTD Risk Management Committee Representative, a Deputy Agency Director or higher (or equivalent position), and head(s) of facilities/maintenance. The goal of this review is to identify claim trends with an eye to develop ways to reduce the likelihood or severity of future property claims and to identify property loss management strategies to be enhanced through FY2014 and beyond. Reviewers must sign the final page of this report and submit it to RMTD by October 31, 2013, along with a basic plan to address the occurrence of property claims. (Note: To obtain this standard report, access State Agency Loss Reports through RMTD's website, select Standard Reports, select Property, and select Property Claims.)
- 2) Review your property claims activity report for the past four years by October 1, 2013. Reviewers must include at least your contact person for this program, your RMTD Risk Management Committee Representative, a Deputy Agency Director or higher (or equivalent position), and head(s) of facilities/maintenance. The goal of this review is to identify claim trends with an eye to develop ways to reduce the likelihood or severity of future property claims and to identify property loss management strategies to be enhanced through FY2014 and beyond. - 4) Submit blueprint, plans and specifications for renovations or new construction involving or affecting fire suppression systems. RMTD and/or the state's property loss consultants will review materials for system density design, and other concerns. Property loss management recommendations may be made with reasonable follow-up expected of the participant.
- 5) Submit written response to recommendations contained in Property Loss Management letters issued by RMTD and/or its consultants. Responses must indicate that a reasonable effort to comply with recommendations is made.







## Convene a Meeting by October 1:



Convene a meeting to discuss your entity's Property Claims Activity report with a goal of identifying claims trends to develop ways to reduce the likelihood or severity of future property claims and to identify property loss management strategies to be enhanced.

Also develop a basic plan to address the occurrence of property claims.

## Convene a Meeting by October 1:



This meeting shall involve these individuals at a minimum:

- ✓ Your entity's Property Loss Management Program Contact Person
- ✓ Your entity's RMTD Risk Management Committee Representative  
(See a list of Representatives under "Advisory Groups" at RMTD's web site; [rmtd.mt.gov](http://rmtd.mt.gov))
- ✓ Your entity's head of maintenance/facilities
- ✓ A high level entity manager  
(i.e. Director, President, Deputy Director, Vice President, Institutional Director)

# Convene a Meeting by October 1:



You may find it beneficial to also include individuals such as:

- ✓ Representative(s) of areas identified as producing property claims
- ✓ Individual(s) who complete your entity's reporting of claims to RMTD
- ✓ Representative(s) of those who respond to incidents
- ✓ Representative(s) of your entity's Emergency Action Team, Safety Committee, or other teams
- ✓ Your Risk Management & Tort Defense claims specialist
- ✓ Any other(s)

## Example Questions and Considerations to aid in your review and discussion:




- Are there obvious common factors or similarities among claims?
- Are there redundant claims?
- Are claims seasonal or cyclical occurring on common dates in relation to weeks, months, or other time periods?
- Are claims related to certain locations or units of your entity?
- Are claims related to certain operations or activities?
- Do claims involve common equipment or designs?
- Are there similarities in how or when incidents are discovered?
- Are there common individuals identifiable to the cause, discovery, reporting, or responding to occurrences?
- Have similar unreported incidents or “near misses” occurred?

## Example Questions and Considerations to aid in your review and discussion:



- Discuss large value claims.
- Do low value claims have high level of severity do to non-monetary losses or impacts?
- Could any occurrence have been predicted?
- Was there adherence to existing policies, procedures, or protocols?
- Did adherence/non-adherence contribute to the loss?
- Should existing policies, procedures, or protocols be reviewed or revised?
- Do policies, procedures, or protocols need to be developed?
- Are individuals properly educated and trained?
- Have steps been taken to address reoccurrence of a loss?

# Sign the Report:



Attendees must sign, including their name and title, and date the final page of the reviewed Property Claims Activity report.

(Signature represents that the report has been discussed with the participant's input toward a plan to address the occurrence of future property claims and losses.)


